Stakeholder Collaboration as a Major **Factor for Sustainable Ecotourism Development in Southern Ethiopia**

ABSTRACT

Ecotourism has been championed as a vehicle for sustainable development despite its effectiveness becomes under scrutiny in recent years. Of the various factors discussed in the current literature as hindrances to the success of ecotourism, a lack of stakeholder collaboration is discussed. Drawing upon stakeholder and collaboration theories and on triple-bottom-line principles, this research aims to investigate the contributions of effective stakeholder collaboration to sustainable ecotourism. The study adopts an exploratory research design and conducts in-depth interviews and focus group discussions with pertinent stakeholders. Research findings revealed poor interactions and collaborations amongst ecotourism stakeholders. Consequently. ecotourism in southern Ethiopia accelerates the degradation of natural resources, by overlooking communities while benefiting other ecotourism stakeholders. Therefore, in poorly resourced and remote destinations, failure to empower and participate communities does not only undermine the sustainable development of ecotourism but also jeopardizes the natural ecosystem and thereby the survival of communities themselves.

Dr. Amare Wondirad is an Assistant Professor at Sol International Hospitality Management (SIHOM), Sol International School, Woosong University. He has also served as a Lecturer and an Assistant Professor at The University of Gondar and Hawassa University respectively. Dr. Wondirad completed his Ph.D. at The School of Hotel and Tourism Management, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University in 2018. His research interests lie in the broader area of sustainable tourism, which comprises ecotourism, tourism policy and planning, community-based tourism, and small-scale tourism business development in addition to some other research areas such as tourist satisfaction, cruise tourism, and culinary tourism.
